What happened to the millions of doses Canada promised to the world?

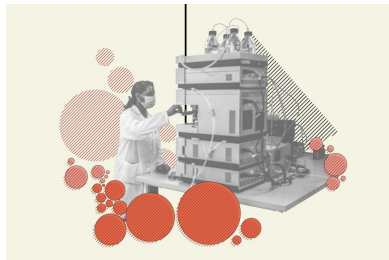
